### Issue Positions/Platform

Bryan Greene seeks to ensure that every American continues to live in a nation where freedom rings over every hilltop and every plain, where one's privacy is kept safe while morals and principles are upheld and the people are kept safe and secure. Bryan Greene takes the following stands:

- The US Constitution gave us a Republic, not a Democracy, rooted in Biblical law that is to bind government under rules to protect the rights of the United States citizen and ensure this nation remains free. I promise to obey the US Constitution and vote to reduce federal government power, by returning that power to its rightful owners; the states and the people.
- Life begins from the very moment of *conception*, therefore abortion for any reason is murder, and should be illegal; no exceptions.
- I believe that this nation was founded a Christian nation, and for this very reason, people of other faiths are and should always be *afforded freedom of religion and worship in the US*.
- *Law-abiding individuals have the right to keep, bear and use firearms of any kind, as it is their inalienable right to defend themselves.* The 2<sup>nd</sup> Amendment does not allow restrictions on ownership, carrying, or concealment of firearms or the type of firearm an individual can own.
- Every individual has the *right to own property* and to do with that property as they see fit without unnecessary government restrictions.
- I strongly oppose same-sex marriage, yet do not support a federal marriage amendment because it is a state's right. The Constitution delegates all powers not given to the federal government to the states and the people; therefore, I support a marriage amendment on the state level.
- I strongly advocate states rights, and believe that the federal government's power must be drawn back as delegated by the US Constitution and that power returned to the states.
- I support a strong national defense along with a non-interventionist foreign policy as the founders envisioned.

- I believe parents have the right to decide where their child will receive his/her education and *should only have to pay for their child's education*. The federal Department of Education should be abolished because the education of our children belongs to the people and the states. The federal government has no right to be involved in the education system.
- I oppose universal healthcare (government healthcare). This type of healthcare makes doctors and medical staff accountable to the government not the patient and will lead to lesser quality medical care and allow the government to decide whether you get medical treatment.
- I oppose the United Nations.
- *We must end the Iraqi war*, it is an unconstitutional war declared by the President of the United States whereas ONLY the US Congress has the right to declare war. In addition, it is not the job of the US to police the world and to spread democracy through military force as we have done in Iraq.
- We must *immediately* begin withdrawing our troops from Iraq. We should begin by withdrawing the troops in small increments over a period of about 6 months, by which time all US troops need to be withdrawn. At the same time, the United States needs to maintain diplomacy with Iraq and help establish good diplomatic relations between Iraq's neighboring countries to assist in stabilizing Iraq and the Middle East.
- *The Real ID Act is an unconstitutional violation of privacy and security of the people's private information*, while establishing a national ID card that usurps the constitutional authority of the states. The Real ID Act should be repealed.
- *US Borders should be more secured with the completion of a strong border fence and enforcement of current border laws*. I oppose the granting of any amnesty to illegal aliens or a guest worker program that would give a path to citizenship that would reward their illegal activities.
- I support English as the official language for business in the United States of America.
- The USA Patriot Act of 2001 and the Military Commissions Act of 2006 are unconstitutional, abridge American's 1st, 4th and 6th Amendment Rights, and should be repealed.
- I will never vote to increase taxes on the American people. I will vote to lower income, estate, gift and other taxes with a goal of completely ending these taxes and eliminating the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) and Federal Reserve System while replacing these taxes with a less repressive and constitutional form of indirect taxation. Examples of those forms of taxation I support are:
  - Import taxes to encourage domestically made products, prevent outsourcing of US jobs and increase the supply of jobs.
  - Sales taxes, so that the individual is taxed on items they voluntarily purchase.
